

I, LAURA A. ALLIGER, of Katonah, Town of Bedford, County of Westchester and State of New York, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do hereby make, publish and declare this to be my LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT in the manner and form following:

FIRST:- I direct my Executors hereinafter named to pay all my just debts and funeral expenses and it is my desire that my wedding ring be left with me and that my body be cremated.

SECOND:- I give, devise and bequeath to my husband, LEWIS A. ALLIGER, my home and all real estate of which I die seized and possessed for his use during the term of his natural life, and upon his death I hereby authorize and direct my Executors hereinafter named to sell said house and said real estate as one parcel or in parcels at a price or prices which said Executors, in their sole discretion, shall consider for the best interest of my estate and the proceeds from the sale of said house and real estate, after the deduction of the expenses in connection with the said sale or sales thereof, I authorize and direct my Executors hereinafter named to divide equally and pay over the same to my daughters, ROSAMOND WOLF and PATRICIA DURAND, share and share alike.

THIRD:- I authorize and direct my Executors hereinafter named, as soon after my demise as is practicable, to sell, transfer and deliver all stocks and bonds which I own at the time of my death and to pay over the proceeds thereof, after deducting the cost in connection with the sale thereof, to my daughters, ROSAMOND WOLF and PATRICIA DURAND, share and share alike.

FOURTH:- I give and bequeath to my grandson, JAMES LEWIS WOLF, son of my daughter Rosamond Wolf, the sum of Three Hundred Dollars.

FIFTH:- I give and bequeath to my grandson, HARRY WHITNEY DURAND, III, son of my daughter Patricia Durand, the sum of Three Hundred Dollars.

SIXTH:- I direct that the bequests under Paragraphs "Fourth" and "Fifth" be paid by my Executors hereinafter named out of the balance of my savings account in the Interest Department of the Northern Westchester Bank, Katonah, New York, and that if there be any balance in said savings account, after the payment of said bequests, I hereby direct my Executors hereinafter named to divide the same equally and pay the same to my granddaughter, CAROL ANN WOLF, daughter of my daughter Rosamond Wolf, and to my granddaughter, LAURA AMES DURAND, daughter of my daughter Patricia Durand, share and share alike.

TWELFTH:- I give and bequeath all other small silver articles, spoons, pickle forks, coffee spoons, serving spoons, china and glass in corner cupboards, china and wooden dogs, all books belonging to Thornton S. Hardy and all oriental rugs marked with a square of cloth and a number to my daughters, ROSAMOND WOLF and PATRICIA DURAND, to be divided equally between them, share and share alike.

THIRTEENTH: I authorize and direct my Executors herein-after named to pay any and all Inheritance and Estate Taxes that may be charged against my estate out of the proceeds of the sale of the stocks and bonds which I own at the time of my death, before the bequests are paid under Paragraph "Third", and if the

proceeds of sale are insufficient therefor, then I authorize and direct my Executors hereinafter named to pay any or all Inheritance and Estate Taxes that may be charged against my estate out of the proceeds of sale of the real estate before the devise and bequests under Paragraph "Second" are made.

FOURTEENTH:- All the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, both real and personal and wheresoever situate, not specifically hereinbefore bequeathed or devised in this my LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT I give, devise and bequeath to my daughters, ROSAMOND WOLF and PATRICIA DURAND, to be divided equally between them, share and share alike.

FIFTEENTH:- I hereby authorize and empower my Executors hereinafter named to sell any and all real estate of which I die seized, either at public or private sale, and to make, execute and deliver good and sufficient deed or deeds of conveyance therefor.

SIXTEENTH:- I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my husband, LEWIS A. ALLIGER, and EDWIN B. COVEY of Katonah, New York, or the survivor of them, Executors of this my LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT and authorize and direct that they be appointed as such without being required to give bonds or surety, hereby revoking all former wills by me at any time made.
